

Disclosure of: criminal convictions, cautions or bind-overs

Applicants to all courses organised by the College of Osteopaths are required to disclose details of all criminal convictions, cautions or bind-over orders that are not spent. You must disclose all such matters but you can be assured that only those deemed relevant to the programme will be considered.

Please complete the following declaration as appropriate and return along with your application form.

Osteopaths are exempt from the Rehabilitation of Offenders Acts and if at some time you have been found guilty of a criminal offence you may not be able to register with the General Osteopathic council even if you have completed a BSc (Hons) Osteopathy programme successfully. If you are unsure whether this could apply to you, please contact the General Osteopathic Council.

Failure to complete this form, or to disclose any convictions, cautions or bind-over orders, may result in an offer of place on the programme being withdrawn, or dismissal from a programme.
