Extract from January 2024 & September 2024 T&Cs:

10. CHANGES TO COURSES AND SERVICES

- 10.1 The College will use all reasonable endeavours to deliver teaching and related educational and other services and facilities required for your programme in accordance with the description applied to it in the academic year in which you begin the programme. However, the College will be entitled to make reasonable changes to the course or to other related educational and other services and facilities where that will enable the College to deliver a better quality of educational experience to students enrolled on the programme.
- 10.2 Such changes may be to:
 - (a) the content and syllabus of the programme, including in relation to placements;
 - (b) the timetable, location and number of classes;
 - (c) the structure and/or timing of the academic year;
 - (d) the method of delivery of courses, services and facilities; and
 - (e) the examination and assessment process.
- 10.3 In making any such changes, the College will aim to keep the changes to the minimum necessary to achieve the required quality of experience and will consult with affected students in advance about any changes that are required. If the College changes your programme and you are not satisfied with the changes, you will be offered the opportunity to withdraw from the programme and, if required, offered reasonable support to move to another provider.
